Re: Tournament Schedule and Championship Execution

This memo is to outline the 2025 SICC tournament season schedule and process and procedures for the SICC Club Championship Tournament.

The events are primarily scheduled on Sunday evenings in the off-season. Each tournament will have a \$20 entry fee per player that will be split evenly between the club and the prize pool. Fifty percent (50%) of the entry fees will be returned to the winners at a distribution of 50% to the winners (split in the event of gross and net), 30% to the second place participants, and 20% to the third place participants. In the events with both gross and net winners, the prize pool will be paid out at 30% to each winner low gross and net, 20% to each 2nd low gross and net.

Tuesday 2-Person Scramble matches can be played **any time** on Tuesday with a \$20 entry fee **per team** (non-members will be responsible for regular greens and cart fees). Please pay at the Clubhouse before playing your 9-hole round and turn in witness signed score cards upon completion. Winning teams in both the Gross and Net categories will split the winnings, which will be awarded the following Tuesday.

Event tournaments will be capped at 36 participants, all of whom must be pre-paid and registered no later than close of business the Friday before the event. If a participant has no handicap, they will participate with a "0" handicap and encouragement to build their handicap. Late registration will be at the discretion of the Golf Committee.

Each event tournament shall have a designated tournament director who shall have final say on all matters pertaining to that particular event. No member of the board or club shall interfere with that director's efforts in executing the event as a matter of respect to that person's unpaid contribution to the club's activities. Tournament directors need not be members of the Board.

Club Championship Format: Match Play

- Men's
 - Championship (White Tees)
 - 18 hole qualifying round
 - 36 hole final
 - A-Flight, B-Flight, etc. as necessary (White Tees)
 - Golfers placed by Handicap
 - Senior Championship Flight (Gold Tees)
 - 18 hole qualifying round
 - Senior A-Flight, B-Flight, etc. as necessary (White Tees)
 - Golfers placed by Handicap
- Women's
 - Championship Flight (Red Tees)
 - 18 hole qualifying round
 - A-Flight, B-Flight, etc. as necessary (Red Tees)
 - Golfers Placed by Handicap
- **Schedule:**
 - All Qualifying Rounds must be played from July 7 – July 21
 - (18 hole) scorecard must be handed in and signed by a witness(s)
 - 2 (9 hole) rounds may be recorded to achieve an 18 hole score
 - Flights posted July 25

- Opening Round Matches: August 4-August 10
- Semifinal Round Matches: August 11-August 18
- Championship Rounds: **Sunday 8/24, Tee Times TBD**

The winner of each flight's 2024 tournament shall be the top seed in their respective bracket, with the runner-up designated the second seed unless that participant moves into another bracket. The number of flights will be determined by the number of qualified entrants. Entry to the club championship shall be **free of charge**, with the winners' accomplishments to be commemorated for all time via plaque on the walls of the clubhouse.

Each tournament round played shall incur the usual and customary charges to players such that the club does not subsidize cart rentals, etc. Each player shall pay the member rate for a cart, unless the member has his or her own cart for use, with an executed and paid cart storage agreement. These fees are independent of the registration fees and shall not be included for distribution to the prize pool.

Club championship play will be match play until one player has won a sufficient number of holes as to preclude his or her opponent from winning. At whatever point a player wins his or her match, they shall notify the tournament committee and our brackets will be updated and published on social media, and our website, as resources allow.

Members are responsible for arranging their matches within the designated week for the appropriate round. In the event a member cannot play during the aforementioned time window designated for the round, the member shall forfeit the match. Dates are now published well ahead of the tournament so any conflict may be resolved in advance. Emergency events will be considered on a case-by-case basis. **ONLY GOLF COMMITTEE MAY EXTEND THE TIME BY WHICH A MATCH MUST BE COMPLETED.** In the event a player defaults due to inability to play, his or her opponent will be promoted to the next round of play.

Each player in any match may provide their own spotters/caddies. Spotters/caddies may also move ahead to non-match players on the course to request matches be allowed to play through, as necessary.

All decisions and rulings of the Golf Committee are final.
